Purpose: The network offers a powerful connection among immunization providers and supporters to share information, best practices and serve as a collective voice to advocate for vaccines in Ohio.


Mission: To advocate for the value of vaccines and educate on the critical role of immunization to maintain healthy communities, schools, workplaces and institutions of Ohio.
